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Organizational and Technical Requirements

-  Each participant (solo/duet/trio/group) - 1 performance of up to 5 minutes. **Instrumental categories - up to 10 minutes.**
-  Theatre - études/excerpts up to 15 minutes; small forms - up to 10 minutes.
-  Film and animation - 1-15 minutes.
-  Visual arts/photography - 1 work (format $\leq$ A3). **Theme: "Autumn Blues".**
-  Video - a link to YouTube, Google Drive, or another video hosting/cloud storage service. Access to the material must be open to anyone with the link.
-  Recording without editing or special effects (except for music videos).
-  Recording - good quality, filmed in a wide shot, with the performer(s) wearing stage attire.
-  Performance - accepted in any language.
-  Materials (biography and other additional information) are accepted in Polish, English, Belarusian, Russian, or Ukrainian.
-  Participants are responsible for respecting copyright.
-  The Organizing Committee reserves the right to use competition materials without payment of royalties.

Code of Conduct with Children and Youth (Foundation Inicjatywa)

We work with children and young people of different ages, cultures, languages, and life experiences, including children with migration and refugee backgrounds.

Our priority is the safety, respect, and well-being of the child.

-  **Safety** – physical, emotional, and psychological. Physical contact is possible only when necessary (e.g., threat to health) and with the consent of the child/parent.
-  **Understanding and respectful communication** – we do not shout, humiliate, or shame. We explain the rules calmly and respectfully.
-  **Right to play and self-expression** – play is important for development and integration. We support the child's creative self-expression.
-  **Equality and inclusion** – all children are equal, regardless of language, culture, gender, religion, or nationality. No one is singled out or discriminated against.
