Age Categories

- **MIX** — mixed category (except EXTRA)
- **EXTRAMIX** — mixed category including 23+ participants (e.g., student + teacher)

- 🎭 Theater – sketches/excerpts up to 15 minutes, small forms – up to 10 minutes.
- 🎬 Cinema and Animation – 1–15 minutes.
- 🎨 Fine Arts/Photography – 1 work (format ≤ A3). **Theme: Spring Awakening**
- 📺 Video – YouTube link (no restrictions).
- 🚫 Recording without editing or special effects (except music videos).
- 📹 Shooting – high quality, wide shot, stage costume required.
- 📄 Materials (bio and additional information) are accepted in: **Polish, English, Belarusian, Russian, Ukrainian.**
- ⚖️ Participants are responsible for compliance with copyright.
- 🏛️ The Organizing Committee has the right to use contest materials without payment of royalties.

Code of Conduct with Children and Youth (Foundation Inicjatywa)

We work with children and young people of different ages, cultures, languages, and life experiences, including children with migration and refugee backgrounds.
